Subject: Submission of Revised Form 1951-G to Replace Form 1951-F

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to SoCalGas' tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to revise Form 1951-F, Transfer of Service Pipe to Yard Piping, to better inform customers of their responsibility for maintenance, upkeep and operation of the portion of the service pipe that has been transferred as yard piping, as set forth in Tariff Rule 26, Consumer Responsible for Equipment for Receiving Gas.

Background

Form 1951-F was filed on May 16, 1974 and became effective on June 15, 1974. The proposed revised Form 1951-G includes a space for the customer's signature providing SoCalGas written verification that the customer is aware of the addition to his yard piping. By signing the form, the customer acknowledges that he is bound by Tariff Rule 26, which is reproduced as part of Form 1951-G.

This filing will not increase or decrease any rate or charge, conflict with any schedules or rules, nor cause the withdrawal of service.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. Rule 26

CONSUMER RESPONSIBLE FOR EQUIPMENT FOR RECEIVING GAS

- A. The consumer shall, at his own risk and expense, furnish, install and keep in good and safe condition all regulators, gas mains, appliances, fixtures and apparatus, which may be required for receiving gas from the Company, and for applying and utilizing such gas, including all necessary protective appliances and suitable building therefor, and the Company shall not be responsible for any loss or damage occasioned or caused by the negligence, want of proper care, or wrongful act of the consumer or of any of his agents, employees or licensees on the part of consumer installing, maintaining, using, operating, or interfering with any such regulators, service pipes, gas mains, appliances, fixtures or apparatus.
- B. In those cases where the gas meter is so set as to require use by the Company of all or a portion of the house line and/or yard pipe belonging to some party other than the Company, then and in any such event such party shall be responsible, and the Company shall not be responsible, for the operation and maintenance of such house line and/or yard pipe so used by the Company and for any and all injuries and damages resulting from the escape of gas therefrom.
