Subject: List of Contracts and Deviations

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

The purpose of this clean-up filing is to delete obsolete entries in the List of Contracts and Deviations (List). After a careful and thorough review, however, it has come to SoCalGas' attention that a Displacement Agreement with PG&E originally executed on July 23, 1993 and its subsequent amendments were inadvertently not listed. Therefore, SoCalGas submits herewith a revised List containing only contracts that are still effective including the said Displacement Agreement. All other obsolete entries have been deleted.

This filing will not increase or decrease any rate or charge, conflict with any schedules or rules, or cause the withdrawal of service.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the California Public Utilities Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
