Subject: Areawide Public Utility Contract

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revision to its tariff, List of Contracts and Deviations, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B, to include a contract with a governmental agency for natural gas service as shown on Attachment C. This advice filing is made in compliance with General Order 96-A, Section X.B.

Purpose

This filing submits the Areawide Public Utility Contract (Agreement) between the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) and SoCalGas for gas and gas transportation services, as defined in Article 1.1(e) of the Agreement, for the next 10 years. This Agreement renews a similar contract initially executed with GSA in 1984, and subsequently renewed in 1994 and submitted to the Commission in Advice No. 2342 dated August 11, 1994.

Information

The Agreement provides that SoCalGas will furnish gas and gas transportation service to the Federal Government in accordance with SoCalGas' currently effective rules and tariffs. The Agreement does not commit either side to any service; it merely provides the framework and mechanism to expedite the process by which Federal agency contracting officers can acquire for their clients SoCalGas' products and services so enumerated in the Agreement.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
