**Subject:** Delete Electronic Bulletin Board Monthly Fees from Rule No. 33 in Compliance

with the Cost of Service Decision No. 04-12-015

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions applicable to its tariffs as shown on Attachment B.

### <u>Purpose</u>

This filing is being made in compliance with SoCalGas Test Year 2004 Cost of Service (COS) Decision (D.) 04-12-015 which allows SoCalGas to, among other things, recover the cost to develop its new gas management system, known as Envoy and referred to in SoCalGas' tariff as Electronic Bulletin Board (EBB), in customer rates. Currently, development costs for SoCalGas' gas management systems are recovered through a monthly base fee and usage fee paid by system users only, as directed in D.93-12-043, SoCalGas' Test Year 1994 General Rate Case decision. With the inclusion of Envoy development costs in SoCalGas' base margin authorized in D.04-12-015, it is no longer appropriate to charge these fees directly to system users and therefore references to the fees are being deleted from Rule No. 33, Electronic Bulletin Board (EBB).

### Background

On February 15, 1994, SoCalGas filed Advice No. (AL) 2272, in compliance with D.93-12-043, to revise Rule No. 33 to authorize SoCalGas to charge transporters of gas on the SoCalGas system, and other users, for the use of GasSelect, SoCalGas' gas management system at that time. On September 23, 1994, AL 2272 was supplemented in response to Commission issued Resolution G-3121, dated September 15, 1994, that required SoCalGas to make several modifications to the GasSelect fee structure.

As part of Application (A.)12-02-027, SoCalGas' COS, filed on December 20, 2002, SoCalGas requested to include costs related to the development of a new gas management system in customer rates (p. SE-8 of COS Direct Testimony of Sarah Edgar) with the explanation that all customers benefit from the system not just the direct users. D.04-12-015 approved the requested method of cost recovery. As a result, system users will no longer need to pay the monthly base fee and usage fee. Therefore, Section G., CHARGES, of Rule No. 33 that provides the details of these fees is being deleted in its entirety.

In 2004, SoCalGas charged EBB fees totaling \$615,194 to recover its cost for providing such services while awaiting a decision from the Commission in A.12-02-027. With the issuance of D.04-12-015, SoCalGas proposes to credit the Cost of Service Revenue Requirements Memorandum Account (COSRRMA) with EBB fees collected during 2004.

#### **Effective Date**

SoCalGas respectfully requests that this filing become effective February 1, 2005, to be concurrent with the other rate changes which are being filed on this same date in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 4 of D.04-12-015.

### **Protest**

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter was filed with the Commission. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. ### E. AUTHORIZED INDIVIDUAL USERS

Authorized User shall allow only its specifically authorized employees and/or agents access to and use of EBB and all Software Programs and Software Documentation. Authorized User shall identify each and every such individual to Utility prior to their use of EBB.

Authorization is limited strictly to such individuals until such time as User requests otherwise. In the event such individual's authorization to use system is terminated for whatever reason, including but not limited to a change in employment and/or the necessity to change authorization to another person or persons, authorized User must provide Utility immediate notice thereof and must request any new authorizations required as a consequence.

### F. <u>UTILITY REPRESENTATION</u>

- 1. Utility's provision of access to EBB and any and all use thereof is strictly on an informational basis only.
- 2. Utility does not warrant that Software Programs will meet authorized User's requirements or that their operation will be uninterrupted or error-free.
- 3. Utility's provision of access to EBB and its maintenance thereof shall in no way be construed as to imply or provide any warranty, sponsorship, or approval by Utility as to the efficacy of EBB nor of any of the arrangements or relationships made by or based on the use of EBB by authorized User or any agent(s) acting on User's behalf.
- 4. Utility expressly disclaims any warranty, representation or opinion, whether expressed or implied, as to the legal enforceability of any relationship which authorized User may enter into associated in any way with information obtained from EBB.
- 5. The establishment, maintenance or termination of any commercial or legal relationship(s) between authorized User and any other party or parties ("Third Parties") based in whole or in part on information obtained from EBB are the sole responsibility of the authorized User and such Third Parties.
- 6. Authorized User shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend Utility, its officers, agents and employees, against any and all loss, damage, expense and/or liability arising out of or in any way connected with the performance or non-performance of EBB, however caused, except to the extent caused by active negligence or willful misconduct of Utility, its officers, agents and employees.
