Subject: SHARABLE EARNINGS AND PERFORMANCE INCENTIVES FOR YEAR 2004

Purpose

California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Decision (D.) 05-03-023 directs Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) to file a compliance advice letter each May 1 to calculate earnings sharing and performance incentives related to the prior year. The purpose of this Advice Letter is to inform the Commission that earnings sharing and performance incentives for SoCalGas are not applicable for 2004.

Background

On March 17, 2005, the Commission issued D.05-03-023 regarding the post-test year 2004 ratemaking, earnings sharing, and incentive proposals phase (Phase II) of SoCalGas' Cost of Service (COS) proceeding. The Decision adopts modified reliability incentives for SoCalGas that set reasonable targets and include appropriate rewards and penalties.

D.05-03-023 authorized an earnings sharing mechanism and performance for SoCalGas, and requires SoCalGas to file an annual advice letter to calculate sharable earnings related to the prior year. Specifically:

SoCalGas will file an advice letter providing sharable earnings according to the financial sharing mechanism described in Section G. If there are any sharable earnings, the earning allocated to ratepayers under the mechanism will be included in rates on January 1 of the subsequent year. For performance indicators, any reward or penalty will be authorized in rates upon approval of the advice letter. SoCalGas will submit its sharable earnings advice letter on May 1 of the following

year, which includes workpapers detailing operating results for SoCalGas' base rates.¹

However, D.05-03-023 also orders that there be no earnings sharing or performance incentives for SoCalGas in 2004:

The otherwise adopted sharing mechanism does not apply for SoCalGas and SDG&E to 2004.²

Accordingly, SoCalGas submits this advice letter to comply with the requirement to report on sharable earnings and performance incentives each May 1, but only to inform the Commission that earnings sharing and performance incentives for SoCalGas is not applicable to 2004.

This filing will not create any deviations from SoCalGas' tariffs, cause withdrawal of service from any present customer, or impose any more or less restrictive conditions.

Effective Date

SoCalGas believes this filing is subject to Energy Division disposition and therefore respectfully requests that this advice letter become effective on June 1, 2005, which is 30 calendar days after the date filed.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
