Subject: Basic Ordering Agreement between SoCalGas and the U.S. Government

Purpose

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits, in accordance with the provisions of Section X.B of General Order 96-A, a Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA) (Contract 68711-05-G-8628) between SoCalGas and the United States (U.S.) Government, incorporated herein as Attachment C. SoCalGas' List of Contracts and Deviations is being revised accordingly, as shown on Attachment B.

Information

Under Executive Order 13123 dated June 3, 1999, the U.S. Government is authorized and encouraged to enter into contracts with local utilities on a sole source basis to expedite and facilitate the implementation of cost effective energy and water conservation measures, including the use of renewable energy products. As a result, SoCalGas entered into the attached BOA with the U.S. Government to assist with the performance of various utility services on local bases within SoCalGas' service territory.

SoCalGas will not fund the work to be performed under the BOA with Public Purpose Programs funding, nor Demand Side Management (DSM) funding from 1997 or prior DSM program years. Instead, SoCalGas will fund the work using shareholder funds, and will book any resulting net positive revenues to Miscellaneous Revenues.

With the exception of the specifically required federal contract language, contract provisions generally adhere to SoCalGas' standard contract language and tariff requirements. This filing will not increase any rate or charge, conflict with any rate schedules or rules, nor cause the withdrawal of service.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
