Subject: CM Form 2: Notice by Contracted Marketer to Add or Drop Customers

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

This advice letter submits for filing SoCalGas CM Form 2 - Notice by Contracted Marketer to Add or Drop Customers (Form 6597-23). This form has been used by Contracted Marketers for a number of years to specify the SoCalGas customers added or dropped from their contracted marketer account effective the first of the following month.

Background

CM Form 2 - Notice by Contracted Marketer to Add or Drop Customers, is a form that has been used by SoCalGas' Contracted Marketers since 1993 to provide a list of customers they represent to SoCalGas in accordance with their Master Services Contract Schedule B (Form 6597-2). Section 1(B) of Form 6597-2 states "End User – If Customer is a Marketer and/or Core Aggregator, Customer shall, upon request, provide Utility a written list of the end-users it represents as of a date specified by Utility." In the process of reviewing CM Form 2, SoCalGas has determined that in accordance with General Order 96-A, Section II.C (5) Sample Forms, the form should be filed with the Commission. In addition, the form San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) uses to obtain this identical information from its Contracted Marketers is a tariffed form (SDG&E Form 143-1561).

This filing will not create any deviations from SoCalGas' tariffs, cause withdrawal of service from any present customer, or impose any more or less restrictive conditions.

Effective Date

SoCalGas believes that this filing is subject to Energy Division disposition and therefore respectfully requests that this advice letter become effective June 24, 2006, which is not less than thirty (30) calendar days after the date filed.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
