Subject: Expedited Advice Letter Approval for Interstate Pipeline Capacity Contract – Decision 04-09-022

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for approval to acquire transportation capacity on Kern River Gas Transmission Company (KRGT) in compliance with Decision (D.) 04-09-022.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to request approval by the Commission of a capacity assignment transaction with Reliant Energy Services, Inc. (Reliant) and KRGT that will enable SoCalGas to acquire transportation capacity on KRGT. SoCalGas has provided market sensitive information concerning the terms of the proposed capacity assignment transaction in Attachment B to this Expedited Advice Letter to the Energy Division and Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) under the confidentiality provisions of General Order 66-C and Section 583 of the Public Utilities Code and to The Utility Reform Network (TURN) under the confidentiality provisions of a non-disclosure agreement. This Expedited Advice Letter is filed in compliance with the procedures approved in D.04-09-022.

Background

D.04-09-022, was issued, in part, to address the Phase I proposal of SoCalGas, filed in compliance with R.04-01-025, on new capacity contracting procedures that allowed for the utility to acquire core capacity in a more efficient and cost effective manner. The Commission approved procedures for capacity contract approval that rely on consultation between SoCalGas, DRA, TURN, and the Energy Division for all commitments for interstate capacity, and on a capacity planning range based on the utilities' forecasted core average temperature year daily demand. The addition of the proposed KRGT capacity will result in core capacity within the capacity planning range.

Under the interstate capacity acquisition procedure approved in D.04-09-022, contracts for interstate capacity supported by DRA and TURN may be submitted for approval to the Commission by an Expedited Advice Letter. DRA and TURN support this capacity assignment transaction in Attachment B.

Attachment B contains the following confidential documents: Assignment and Consent to Assignment of Firm Transportation Service Agreement with Exhibit A and Second Amendment to Firm Transportation Agreement Contract No. 1716 with Exhibit A. This capacity assignment transaction must be approved by a date certain or terminates by its terms. Accordingly, SoCalGas urges the Commission to approve this Expedited Advice Letter as promptly as possible.

Any consumer groups who are non-market participants who want access to confidential market sensitive information in Attachment B would need to execute a non-disclosure agreement and make a request in writing to Michael R. Thorp, Senior Counsel for SoCalGas, at facsimile number (213) 629-9620.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Expedited Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 10 days of the date this Expedited Advice Letter was filed with the Commission. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
