<u>Subject</u>: Update of CPUC Reimbursement Account Fees in Compliance with Resolution M-4819

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

The purpose of this Advice Letter is to update utility reimbursement account fees, in compliance with California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Resolution M-4819.

Background

Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code provides:

"The Commission shall annually determine a fee to be paid by every electrical, gas, telephone, telegraph, water, sewer system, and heat corporation and every other public utility providing service directly to customers and subscribers and subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission other than a railroad, except as provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 421)."

On June 7, 2007, the Commission issued Resolution M-4819, updating the reimbursement account fees effective July 1, 2007 from \$0.076 to 0.068 cents/therm for gas. Accordingly, SoCalGas is submitting revisions to Preliminary Statement Part II, Summary of Rates and Charges, and Schedule No. G-SRF, Surcharge to Fund Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account, to comply with the Resolution.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
