The GRL procurement rate and GT-RL (CAT) rates are applicable to income-qualified households that meet the requirements for the California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) as set forth in Schedule G-CARE. The CARE discount of 20% is reflected in the GRL and GT-RL rates shown below. Pursuant to D.05-11-027, as modified by D.06-02-034, benefits from cushion gas withdrawal may be applied in order to keep the CARE commodity rate in any winter month from exceeding 80 cents per therm, provided that all benefits have been applied by March 31, 2008.
