# Subject: Establishment of the General Rate Case (GRC) Revenue Requirement Memorandum Account

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

# <u>Purpose</u>

This filing revises Preliminary Statement, Part VI, Description of Regulatory Accounts – Memorandum, and establishes the GRC Revenue Requirement Memorandum Account (GRCRRMA). Pursuant to D.07-12-053, the purpose of GRCRRMA is to track the shortfall or overcollection resulting from the difference between the rates currently in effect and the final rates adopted in phase 1 of SoCalGas' GRC Application (A.) 06-12-010.

# **Background**

SoCalGas filed its GRC application on December 8, 2006. The scope of the proceeding is broad, and includes the traditional review of current utility spending and related issues including investment planning, safety and reliability, customer service, and all aspects of utility operations. Recognizing that the schedule of the proceeding precludes its completion in time for rates to be effective on January 1, 2008, Commission Decision (D.) 07-12-053 issued on December 20, 2007, authorizes SoCalGas to establish a memorandum account, effective January 1, 2008, to track the shortfall or overcollection between the rates currently in effect and the final rates adopted in phase 1 of SoCalGas' GRC A.06-12-010. In addition, pursuant to Ordering Paragraph (OP) 3 and 4 of D.07-12-053, the effective date of the recording this rate differential is January 1, 2008, subject to final determination at a later time after parties have filed and served specific factual and legal argument to assist in this determination. The creation of a memorandum account is consistent with the Commission's objectives to leave both SoCalGas' customers and shareholders essentially indifferent to the precise date that a final decision is issued and GRC rates implemented. In addition, appropriate adjustments shall be made to SoCalGas' Core Fixed Cost Account (CFCA) and Noncore Fixed Cost Account (NFCA) to ensure that the adopted GRC base margin revenue requirement is properly recovered through the regulatory accounts.

# **Protests**

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
