## Subject: New Firm Access Rights Assignment Form

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing revisions to its sample forms filed with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission), applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

#### Purpose

This Advice Letter adds a new form, Firm Access Rights Assignment (Form No. 6825).

## **Background**

On November 14, 2007, the CPUC approved the revised tariffs for Firm Access Rights and OFF System Delivery pursuant to Decisions (D.) 06-04-033 and 06-12-031.

SoCalGas will be providing end-use customers with information regarding this new service and end-use customers will have to decide whether to participate or not to participate in the Open Season process. Schedule No. G-RPA, Special Condition 37 states that "End-use customers entitled to participate in Rounds 1, 2 and 3 may (1) bid on their own behalf, or (2) allow a third party (such as a marketer) to bid on their behalf." SoCalGas originally determined that end-use customers could allow marketers to bid on behalf of end-use customer by using the end-use customer's logon access during the Open Season but that the end-use customer would be awarded the firm access rights and be the contract holder of those rights.

Feedback from various parties to SoCalGas indicates that this process would be administratively burdensome and that some end-use customers would prefer to assign their maximum bidding rights to their gas suppliers. That would enable the gas supplier to bid in Step 2 of the Open Season and be the contract holder of the firm access rights. SoCalGas is proposing a new firm access rights assignment form (Form No. 6825) that would allow the assignment or transfer of the end-use customer's maximum bidding rights, as defined in SoCalGas' Schedule No. G-RPA, to another party. The maximum bidding rights would be irrevocably transferred (unless cancelled prior to the Open Season Step 2) to the other party and the firm access rights awarded during Step 2 of the Open Season would be held in the name of the assignee. The assignment of bidding rights is neither legally binding on the Assignee to bid on behalf of the end-use customer, nor a commitment by the Assignee to use any acquired rights on the end-use customer's behalf. SoCalGas has no knowledge or control over the arrangements between the parties that has led to any assignment.

The assignment form would need to be completed by any end-use customers prior to the start of the Open Season process in order to allow SoCalGas to prepare the contracts, verify credit, and complete other administrative duties necessary for parties to bid for firm receipt point access rights during the Open Season Step 2. SoCalGas has determined that this form must be approved no later that April 1, 2008, in order to provide this option to end-use customers who may wish to assign their bidding rights. If the form is not approved by April 1, 2008, SoCalGas will continue with the open season process as originally envisioned and require that any end-use customer who wants another party to participate on its behalf will need to provide the individual end-use customer's logon access for the open season.

## Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. This assignment is for this first Open Season and for the rights conveyed in the first Open Season for its stated three-year period. By assigning my bidding rights, I understand that I am giving up my rights to participate in the Open Season Step 2 rounds of bidding and to any FAR resulting from the bidding. Any FAR obtained through the use of my assigned bidding rights will belong solely to, and be under the control of, the Assignee. This assignment contains no obligation for Assignee to use these rights for my benefit. However, it is my intent that the assignment and any subsequent FAR will be used by the entity designated to supply gas on my behalf. I will clarify with the Assignee the use for my benefit, if any, of the FAR in a separate agreement or understanding. SoCalGas provides no right or remedy for me to re-acquire any rights awarded during the Step 2 process to Assignee. I understand that Assignee must meet all of the terms and conditions for acquiring FAR including contractual and credit obligations to obtain FAR through the Step 2 process.

This assignment may be revoked by Assignor at any time upon written notice to SoCalGas provided it is received by SoCalGas no later than 10 days prior to the beginning of Step 2 of the Open Season by contacting:
