<u>Subject</u>: Amendment III to the California Wholesale Gas Transportation and Storage Service Agreement between SoCalGas and Southwest Gas Corporation

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approval Amendment III to the California Wholesale Gas Transportation and Storage Service Agreement (Agreement) between SoCalGas and Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest).

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this Advice Letter is to terminate, in particular, Exhibit C, Storage Services, to the Agreement dated March 4, 1993. Exhibit C specifies the terms and conditions under which SoCalGas provides storage service to Southwest.

### **Background**

The Agreement was approved by Commission Decision (D.) 93-07-052 dated July 21, 1993. Pursuant to the Agreement, SoCalGas provides wholesale gas service to Southwest's service territory in Southern California, excluding Needles, California. The Agreement, including Exhibit C, expires on August 1, 2008.

In Ordering Paragraph 34 of D.07-12-019, dated December 6, 2007, the Commission ordered SoCalGas to offer initial reservations of storage capacity on an annual basis for wholesale core customer requirements at the same time as core storage reservations are made for San Diego Gas & Electric Company and prior to the release of storage capacity for Schedule G-TBS (Transaction Based Storage) service to noncore customers. On January 17, 2008, in compliance with D.07-12-019, SoCalGas offered storage capacity to Southwest for its core requirements. SoCalGas also offered to relieve Southwest of obligations under the Agreement by providing for early termination of Exhibit C, in particular, effective April 1, 2008. Southwest accepted SoCalGas' offer on January 22, 2008.

The duly executed Amendment III to the Agreement is attached hereto as Attachment B.

### **Protest**

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. # AMENDMENT III OF CALIFORNIA WHOLESALE GAS TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE SERVICE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Southern California Gas Company ("SoCalGas") and Southwest Gas Corporation ("Southwest") are parties to that certain California Wholesale Gas Transportation and Storage Service Agreement dated March 4, 1993;

WHEREAS, SoCalGas and Southwest have entered into a Transaction Based Storage Service Agreement effective April 1, 2008;

WHEREAS, SoCalGas and Southwest desire to amend the terms of Exhibit C, Storage Services, to the Wholesale Gas Transportation and Storage Service Agreement dated March 4, 1993 so as to terminate that Exhibit C effective April 1, 2008; and,

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein, SoCalGas and Southwest agree as follows:

- 1. Exhibit C to the California Wholesale Gas Transportation and Storage Service Agreement dated March 4, 1993, is hereby amended by adding an additional Section 4. stating:
  - "4. Irrespective of Section 2.1 of the Agreement, Exhibit F to the Agreement, and/or the May 17, 1993 Letter of Understanding, this Exhibit C shall terminate upon the April 1, 2008 effective date of the Transaction Based Storage Service Agreement executed between the Parties."
- 2. This Amendment becomes effective upon approval by the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC").

3. Notwithstanding the Amendment's Section 2., above, should CPUC's approval occur after April 1, 2008, SoCalGas shall refund to Southwest all fees, services charges, and other associated payments made by Southwest to SoCalGas pursuant to Exhibit C to the California Wholesale Gas Transportation and Storage Service Agreement dated March 4, 1993, for storage service on or after April 1, 2008. In recognition that SoCalGas will refund all fees incurred on or after April 1, 2008, Southwest authorizes SoCalGas to modify its systems to prevent Southwest from using, (and Southwest shall not use) the storage capacity, withdrawal, and injection rights pertaining to those fees and such Exhibit C on or after April 1, 2008.
