Subject: Revision to Gas Line Extension Contract for Orange County Transportation Authority CNG Station

Pursuant to Section 8.2.3 of General Order 96-B, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing a revision to the Gas Line Extension Contract for Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) CNG Station to reflect the change discussed below.

Purpose

This filing modifies the Gas Line Extension Contract Addendum between SoCalGas and OCTA, as originally filed by Advice No. (AL) 3585 on January 27, 2006. The Line Extension Contract Addendum provides that OCTA will "pay within 30 days of invoice." Due to OCTA's process of obtaining board approval for payment, which takes more than 30 days, OCTA and SoCalGas are herein proposing to revise the number of days from 30 to 120 in the first sentence of the second paragraph under Section I.A of the Addendum. The revised Addendum is shown on Attachment B.

Background

AL 3585 requested approval of the Gas Line Extension Contract and Addendum for gas service for a new CNG transit bus refueling center (Facility) located in Santa Ana, California. The proposed load of almost 4 million therms per year required approximately 2.8 miles of main installation and was estimated to cost approximately \$4.7 million. Because these gas facilities were necessary only to serve this Facility for the foreseeable future, it was inequitable to impose all project costs (in excess of any allowances) entirely on SoCalGas ratepayers. Therefore, SoCalGas and OCTA negotiated the Agreement for a gas line extension under which SoCalGas agreed to provide allowances and cost sharing of 50% of all costs, and OCTA agreed to provide a like amount. AL 3585 was approved on February 26, 2006.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the California Public Utilities Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
