Subject: Expedited Advice Letter Request for Approval to Acquire Additional Interstate Transportation Capacity on Transwestern Pipeline Company

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing with and approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to acquire an additional interstate transportation capacity contract on Transwestern Pipeline Company (TW) in compliance with Decision (D.) 04-09-022.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to request approval by the Commission to acquire an additional interstate transportation capacity contract on TW.

Background

D.04-09-022 was issued, in part, to address the Phase I proposal of SoCalGas, filed in compliance with R.04-01-025, on new capacity contracting procedures that allowed for the utility to acquire core capacity in a more efficient and cost effective manner. The Commission approved procedures for capacity contract approval that rely on consultation between SoCalGas, Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA), The Utility Reform Network (TURN), and the Energy Division for all commitments for interstate capacity, and on a capacity planning range based on the utility's forecasted core average temperature year daily demand. Together with existing capacity and other future capacity additions, this additional TW contract will contribute towards meeting the capacity planning range for the consolidated SoCalGas/SDG&E core portfolio.

Under the interstate capacity acquisition procedure approved in D.04-09-022, contracts for interstate capacity supported by DRA and TURN may be submitted for approval to the Commission by an Expedited Advice Letter. DRA and TURN have authorized SoCalGas to state that they support this additional TW capacity. The specific terms of this capacity transaction are set forth in Confidential Attachments B and C.

The Confidential Attachments B and C are provided to Energy Division, Legal Division, and DRA under the confidentiality provisions of General Order 66-C and Section 583 of the California Public Utilities Code and to TURN under the confidentiality provisions of a non-disclosure agreement. Attachment B contains a confidential summary of the contractual terms of the agreement. Attachment C contains confidential Letter Agreement between TW and SoCalGas, including Service Agreement, and associated Appendix A. SoCalGas urges the Commission to approve this Expedited Advice Letter as promptly as possible.

Any consumer groups who are non-market participants who want access to confidential market sensitive information in Attachment B and/or C would need to execute a non-disclosure agreement and make a request in writing to Michael R. Protest

Anyone may protest this Expedited Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must be made in writing and received within 10 days of the date this Expedited Advice Letter was filed with the Commission. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
