<u>Subject</u>: Request to Establish a Natural Gas Appliance Testing (NGAT) Memorandum Account

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariffs, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

This filing requests authority from the Commission to establish a Natural Gas Appliance Testing Memorandum Account (NGATMA) to track costs associated with implementing Decision (D.) 08-11-031, the 2009-2011 Low Income Energy Efficiency (LIEE) and California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) Decision. The function of the NGATMA is to track the LIEE-related NGAT costs that are not currently in base rates until those costs are reviewed by the Commission and authorized for recovery through base rates in SoCalGas' next general rate case (GRC).

Background

In D.07-12-051, the Commission expanded its policy direction for the LIEE program by considering LIEE as an energy resource program. D.07-12-051 adopted a programmatic initiative to provide all eligible customers the opportunity to participate in the LIEE program and to offer those who wish to participate all cost-effective energy efficiency measures in their residences by 2020.

D.08-11-031 authorized SoCalGas' LIEE program plans and budget consistent with achieving the Commission's programmatic initiative. D.08-11-031 approved approximately \$1 billion in energy-related low income programs for the four investor-owned utilities (IOUs) for 2009-2011. The Commission, in the decision, reiterated its intent that the LIEE program "evolve into a resource program that garners significant energy savings in our state while providing an improved quality of life for California's low income population".

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In order to promote the strategic direction of the program, D.08-11-031 set aggressive LIEE goals to support its programmatic initiative. SoCalGas' GRC D.08-07-046 authorized SoCalGas \$1.6 million² a year for related NGAT expenses based on an assumption that 45,500³ of the homes to be treated each year would receive NGAT. D.08-11-031, however, set aggressive goals for the number of homes to be treated through the LIEE program in order to meet the Commission's programmatic initiative and directed SoCalGas to treat an average of 133.400 homes⁴ per year during the 2009-2011 program cycle. Based on historical averages, SoCalGas estimates that 90% of the low income households to be treated during 2009-2011 will receive NGAT. For SoCalGas, this represents an average of 120,000 homes (90% of 133,400) – an increase of over 160% per year over the homes authorized in SoCalGas' last GRC. As a result, at the estimated unit price of \$35/home, SoCalGas anticipates that costs will increase by an average of approximately \$2.6 million annually for 2009-2011 to support this initiative.

Further, D.08-11-031 reiterated the Commission's prior clarifications that NGAT is a basic utility service, since promoting customer safety is a general utility function. The Commission confirmed that NGAT is not an appropriate expenditure for LIEE funds and IOUs should be performing this vital safety testing using funding from general rates.

Tariff Changes

In support of the Commission's programmatic initiative and in accordance with the orders and decisions noted above, SoCalGas is revising its Preliminary Statement to establish the Natural Gas Appliance Testing Memorandum Account (NGATMA). This account will track incremental NGAT expenses incurred as a result of the aggressive program goals imposed by D.08-11-031. Costs will be tracked in the NGATMA until those costs are reviewed by the Commission and authorized for recovery through base rates in SoCalGas' next GRC or in a separate proceeding initiated by a formal application.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. 1. <u>Purpose</u>

The NGATMA is an interest bearing memorandum account that is recorded on the Utility's financial statements. The NGATMA tracks the difference between recorded Low-income Energy Efficiency (LIEE)-related NGAT costs and the corresponding authorized costs embedded in base rates. The cost differential is a result of Decision (D.) 08-11-031 which set an aggressive goal for the number of homes to be treated through the LIEE program in order to meet the Commission's programmatic initiative and directed SoCalGas to treat an average of approximately 133,400 homes per year during the 2009-2011 program cycle which is a significant increase from the goal established in SoCalGas' last General Rate Case (GRC).

2. Applicability

See disposition section.

3. Rates

The balance in the NGATMA will be included in gas transportation rates upon Commission approval.

4. Accounting Procedure

The Utility shall maintain the NGATMA by making entries at the end of each month as follows:

- a. A debit entry equal to recorded incremental NGAT costs, those costs not currently embedded in base rates,
- b. An entry for amortization of the NGATMA balance as authorized by the Commission, and
- c. An entry equal to interest on the average of the balance in the account during the month, calculated in the manner described in Preliminary Statement, Part I, J.

5. <u>Disposition</u>

The disposition of the account balance will be addressed in SoCalGas' next GRC.
