<u>Subject</u>: Revisions to Schedule No. G-RPA – Receipt Point Access

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its Schedule No. G-RPA – Receipt Point Access, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to revise Schedule No. G-RPA – Receipt Point Access, to update firm capacity information at SoCalGas' receipt points at the Kramer Junction (KR Kramer Junction) and at North Baja (NBP Blythe) interconnections.

Background

Schedule No. G-RPA, applicable to firm and interruptible receipt point access rights to SoCalGas' transmission system, is one of the several new schedules established to implement the Firm Access Rights (FAR) system and services adopted in Decision (D.) 06-12-031 by Advice No. (AL) 3706 filed on January 29, 2007. This AL was then supplemented in its entirety by AL 3706-A on September 17, 2007 to comply with Resolution G-3407 issued on September 6, 2007. In response to the filed protests to AL 3706-A, SoCalGas agreed to make requested revisions to certain tariffs filed in AL 3706-A. Partial supplemental AL 3706-B was filed on November 2, 2007. The aforementioned ALs were approved by the Commission effective November 16, 2007.

Information

Kern River Gas Transmission Company (Kern River) has received concurrence from the U.S. Department of Transportation, Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration to increase the maximum allowable operating pressure on Kern River's transmission system from 1,200 psig to 1,333 psig (2010 Expansion Project). Kern River's 2010 Expansion Project will result in an increase in receipt capacity at the Kern River Kramer Junction from 500 to 550 MMcf/d.

Requested Revision

SoCalGas requests authorization to increase the receipt capacity at the KR Kramer Junction interconnect shown in Schedule No. G-RPA by 50 MMcf/d, from 500 to 550 MMcf/d. The increase in receipt capacity is due to Kern River's agreement to increase its minimum delivered pressure from 650 psig to 700 psig at the KR Kramer Junction, and will be effective on the inservice date of its 2010 Expansion Project, which occurred on Friday, April 9, 2010. This additional firm receipt capacity is now available for purchase on SoCalGas' EBB system.

Additionally, SoCalGas proposes to reduce the receipt capacity of the NBP Blythe interconnect shown in Schedule No. G-RPA from 1,200 MMcfd to 600 MMcfd. This reduction of receipt capacity is being made to match the amount that is currently available to customers based on final facilities installed.

These changes will impact neither the total system firm receipt capacity from 3,875, nor any of the zone capacities.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
