Re: Withdrawal of SoCalGas Advice No. (AL) 4123 – Revision to Schedule No. G-RPA – Receipt Point Access – OEHI/Gosford Interconnect

SoCalGas hereby withdraws AL 4123 filed on June 8, 2010 to revise Schedule No. G-RPA – Receipt Point Access to update firm capacity information at SoCalGas' receipt point at the Occidental Elk Hills, Inc. (OEHI) Gosford interconnect.

On June 28, 2010, OEHI filed its protest to AL 4123, opposing SoCalGas' reduction of capacity at Gosford from 150 MMcfd to 110 MMcfd. It explained that the only change that occurred at Gosford is the replacement, at OEHI's expense, of a malfunctioning meter and that OEHI will continue to need access to the established150 MMcfd RPA capacity to accommodate its California gas operations. On July 6, 2010, SoCalGas filed a reply to OEHI's protest.

Both parties have been in discussions and now agree that AL 4123 needs to be withdrawn.

This is being served to the parties served with the original AL 4123, which includes parties in A.04-12-004, SI FAR OFF.

### Subject: Revisions to Schedule No. G-RPA - Receipt Point Access

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its Schedule No. G-RPA – Receipt Point Access, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this filing is to revise Schedule No. G-RPA – Receipt Point Access, to update firm capacity information at SoCalGas' receipt point at the Occidental of Elk Hills (OEHI) Gosford interconnect.

### Background

Schedule No. G-RPA, applicable to firm and interruptible receipt point access rights to SoCalGas' transmission system, is one of the several new schedules established to implement the Firm Access Rights (FAR) system and services adopted in Decision (D.) 06-12-031 by Advice No. (AL) 3706 filed on January 29, 2007. This AL was then supplemented in its entirety by AL 3706-A on September 17, 2007 to comply with Resolution G-3407 issued on September 6, 2007. In response to the filed protests to AL 3706-A, SoCalGas agreed to make requested revisions to certain tariffs filed in AL 3706-A. Partial supplemental AL 3706-B was filed on November 2, 2007. The aforementioned ALs were approved by the Commission effective November 16, 2007.

### Information

The interconnection point with OEHI at Gosford was redesigned and built to new flow parameters provided by OEHI. Those parameters specified a revised maximum flow capability of 110 MMcfd from the previously stated maximum of 150 MMcfd.

## Requested Revision

SoCalGas proposes to reduce the receipt capacity of the OEHI Gosford interconnect shown in Schedule No. G-RPA from 150 MMcfd to 110 MMcfd. This reduction of receipt capacity is being made to match the amount that is currently available to customers based on the final facilities installed.

This change will impact neither the total system firm receipt capacity of 3,875 MMcfd, nor any of the zone capacities.

## **Protest**

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is June 28, 2010. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
