<u>Subject</u>: Expedited Advice Letter Approval for Canadian Pipeline Capacity Contracts Renewal—Decision (D.) 04-09-022

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) respectfully requests pre-approval to renew the following transportation capacity contracts: one TransCanada Foothills—B.C. System—Zone 8 contract (Foothills) and five TransCanada NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. Contracts (NOVA).

Purpose

The purpose of this expedited advice letter is to request approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to renew six Canadian transportation capacity contracts described below. These contracts are used to transport natural gas supplies from Canada on behalf of the core customers of SoCalGas and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E).

Background

Under the interstate capacity acquisition procedure approved in D.04-09-022, contracts for interstate capacity supported by the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) and The Utility Reform Network (TURN) may be submitted for approval to the Commission by an Expedited Advice Letter.

DRA and TURN have authorized SoCalGas to state that they support the capacity contracts described below.

Description of Contracts

The terms of the proposed contracts are confidential and are described in Attachment B submitted under the confidentiality provisions of General Order 66-C and Section 583 of the Public Utilities Code and provided only to the Energy Division, DRA and TURN.

This filing will not create any deviations from SoCalGas' tariffs, cause withdrawal of service from any present customer, or impose any more or less restrictive conditions.

Protests

Anyone may protest this advice letter to the Commission. The protest must state the ground upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 10 days of the date this expedited advice letter was filed with the Commission, which is October 4, 2010. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. The address for mailing or delivering a protest to the Commission is:
