Purpose

The purpose of this Advice Letter is to obtain the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approval of the engagement of GL Noble Denton, Inc. ("GL Noble Denton") as the independent qualified third party to review the results of the system expansion study ordered in Decision (D.) 07-12-019. San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) is concurrently filing a similar Advice Letter.

Background

D.07-12-019 at pages 92-93, 107-108 (Finding of Fact No. 55), and 114 (Ordering Paragraph No. 30) approved SoCalGas' and SDG&E's proposal to develop a system expansion study of the SoCalGas/SDG&E interconnect points, backbone system, and storage facilities, and authorized the recovery of all reasonable costs to perform these studies from all customers, including a review performed by an independent third party. The proposal required that the independent third party selected by SoCalGas/SDG&E be approved by the Commission's Energy Division via an Advice Letter. (See Ex. 45, Direct Testimony of Thanathep Trinooson, at 4; Ex. 19, Direct Testimony of Richard Morrow, at page B-4 of Appendix B (Appendix B is the Edison Settlement).

SoCalGas and SDG&E have selected GL Noble Denton as the qualified independent third party to review the system expansion study ordered in D.07-12-019.
