Subject: Establishment of the Honor Rancho Cost Recovery Memorandum Account

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

This filing revises Preliminary Statement, Part VI, Description of Regulatory Accounts – Memorandum, and establishes the Honor Rancho Cost Recovery Memorandum Account (HRCRMA). The purpose of the HRCRMA is to record the incremental costs associated with the Honor Rancho Expansion Project that are in excess of the \$37.4 million cap approved by Decision (D.) 10-04-034.

Background

On July 13, 2009, SoCalGas filed Application (A.) 09-07-014, to amend the Honor Rancho Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN). This application was part of the implementation of the settlement of Phase I of the BCAP and proposes the improvements necessary to add 5 BCF of inventory expansion at the Honor Rancho storage field. Among other things, this application also requests the Commission to approve the revenue requirement, rate treatment and regulatory account for the Honor Rancho Expansion Project.

On April 22, 2010 the Commission granted an amendment to SoCalGas' CPCN in D.10-04-034 which authorizes the construction and operation of the facilities necessary to expand the Honor Rancho natural gas storage facility as set forth in its application. In accordance with that decision, SoCalGas established the Honor Rancho Storage Memorandum Account (HRSMA) to record the incremental capital-related costs (such as depreciation, return on investment and related taxes) associated with the storage assets placed in service for the Honor Rancho Expansion Project, subject to the \$37.4 million cap applicable to capital costs, the revenue requirement associated with the cost of cushion gas procured, and any incremental O&M expenses and oil revenues realized as a result of the Honor Rancho Expansion Project.¹

Establishment of the HRCRMA

SoCalGas will exceed the \$37.4 million cap applicable to capital costs this year. The HRSMA balance will be addressed in SoCalGas' upcoming regulatory balance update filing to be filed on October 17, 2011, which will reflect the incremental capital-related costs associated with project costs up to the \$37.4 million cap as authorized by D.10-04-034.

SoCalGas proposes to establish the HRCRMA, as described in Attachment B, to record the incremental costs associated with the Honor Rancho Expansion Project that are in excess of the \$37.4 million cap. This is consistent with Ordering Paragraph 8 and Conclusion of Law 20 of D.10-04-034 which provides SoCalGas the authority to seek recovery of capital costs that exceed the \$37.4 million cap in a general rate case or other proceeding, but will be required to prove that such costs were appropriate, prudent, and reasonable to the Honor Rancho Expansion Project.

Protests

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is October 27, 2011. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. 1. Purpose

The HRCRMA is an interest bearing account reflected on SoCalGas' financial statements. The purpose of the HRCRMA is to record the incremental costs associated with the Honor Rancho Expansion Project that are in excess of the \$37.4 million cap approved by Decision (D.) 10-04-034.

2. Applicability

This account shall apply to all gas customers.

3. Rates

See Disposition Section.

4. Accounting Procedures

SoCalGas shall maintain the HRCRMA by recording entries at the end of each month as follows:

- a) A debit entry equal to the capital-related costs (such as depreciation, return on investment and related taxes) associated with the portion of storage assets in excess of the \$37.4 million cap and placed in service for the Honor Rancho Expansion Project;
- b) An entry for amortization of the account balance as authorized by the Commission, net of franchise fees and uncollectible (FF&U) costs; and
- c) An entry equal to the interest on the average of the balance in the account during the month, calculated in the manner described in Preliminary Statement, Part I, J.

5. Disposition

The balance in the HRCRMA will be addressed in SoCalGas next Triennial Cost Allocation Proceeding (TCAP) or other appropriate proceeding.
