Subject: Expedited Advice Letter Approval for Renewal of an Interstate Capacity Contract between Southern California Gas Company and Kern River Gas Transmission Company

Purpose

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) respectfully requests approval to renew an interstate capacity contract with Kern River Gas Transmission Company (Kern River).

Background

Under the interstate capacity acquisition procedure approved in Decision (D.) 04-09-022, contracts for interstate capacity supported by the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) and The Utility Reform Network (TURN) may be submitted for approval to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) by an Expedited Advice Letter.

DRA and TURN have authorized SoCalGas to state that they support the capacity contract with Kern River as described below.

Description of Contract

The terms of the contract are confidential and are described in Attachment B submitted under the confidentiality provisions of General Order 66-C and Section 583 of the Public Utilities Code and provided only to the Energy Division, DRA and TURN.

This filing will not create any deviations from SoCalGas' tariffs, cause withdrawal of service from any present customer, or impose any more or less restrictive conditions.

Protests

Anyone may protest this advice letter to the Commission. The protest must state the ground upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 10 days of the date this expedited advice letter was filed with the Commission, which is Monday, April 16, 2012.

There is no restriction on who may file a protest. The address for mailing or delivering a protest to the Commission is:
