<u>Subject:</u> Modification of the 2012-2014 Energy Savings Assistance Programs Memo Account (ESAPMA) Pursuant to Decision (D.) 12-06-030

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 4 of D.12-06-030, dated June 21, 2012, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

This filing modifies the 2012-2014 ESAPMA to track the difference between the extended authorized bridge funding adopted in D.12-06-030 and the corresponding approved budgets adopted in SoCalGas' 2012-2014 California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) and Energy Savings Assistance (ESA) Programs Application (A.)11-05-018.

Background

Pursuant to D.11-11-010, the Commission, on November 10, 2011, authorized SoCalGas and other affected utilities to continue their 2011 CARE and ESA Programs until the Commission adopts a final decision on the utilities' 2012-2014 CARE and ESA Program applications. The decision authorized a monthly CARE and ESA program bridge funding to cover program spending from January 1 through June 30, 2012. On June 21, 2012, the Commission in D.12-06-030 authorized a month-to-month extension of bridge funding beyond June 30, 2012, to ensure that no hiatus occurs after the initial bridge funding expires on June 30, 2012, pursuant to D.11-11-010. The authorized ESA program funding for the extended bridge funding period is based on the utilities' average monthly expenditures for 2011, as augmented, while bridge funding for CARE administrative and subsidy costs remain unchanged from the initial bridge funding authorized and filed in Advice No. 4298.

SoCalGas' authorized month-to-month bridge funding after June 30, 2012 is detailed below.¹

Modification of the 2012-2014 ESAPMA

In compliance with OP 4 of D.12-06-030, SoCalGas is expanding its 2012-2014 ESAPMA to record the difference between the revenue requirement adopted for the extended bridge funding period and the revenue requirement requested in the 2012-2014 CARE and ESA Programs A.11-05-018, et al., beginning on July 1, 2012. The "requested" revenue requirement will be trued-up with the adopted revenue requirement in the Commission's decision on the 2012-2014 CARE and ESA Program applications.

Protest

Anyone may protest this advice letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date this advice letter was filed with the Commission which is July 19, 2012. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. The funding level incorporated in 2012 PPP rates for the ESA program was \$7,531,183, which represents the monthly authorized bridge funding level adopted in D.11-11-010 and filed in Advice No. 4298.

² Monthly ESA program amount reflects the additional \$3.8 million funding for the bridge funding period beyond June 30, 2012 pursuant to OP 1 of D.12-06-030.

1. Purpose

The ESAPMA is an interest bearing memorandum account that is not recorded on SoCalGas' financial statements. Pursuant to D.11-11-010 and D.12-06-030, Bridge Funding for 2012 California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) and Energy Savings Assistance (ESA) Programs, effective January 1, 2012 and July 1, 2012, respectively, the ESAPMA will record the difference between the revenue requirement adopted for the applicable bridge funding period and the revenue requirement requested and eventually approved in the 2012-2014 CARE and ESA Programs Application (A.) 11-05-018.

2. Applicability

See Disposition section.

3. <u>Rates</u>

The balance in the ESAPMA will be included in Public Purpose Program (PPP) gas surcharge rates upon Commission approval.

4. Accounting Procedures

SoCalGas maintains this account by making monthly entries as follows:

- a) A debit entry equal to the authorized monthly revenue requirement for the ESA program and CARE administration costs requested in the 2012-2014 CARE and ESA Program A.11-05-018 (subject to true-up based on the actual revenue requirement adopted in that application),
- b) A credit entry equal to the corresponding authorized monthly revenue requirement for the bridge funding period adopted in D.11-11-010 and D.12-06-030,
- c) An entry for amortization of the ESAPMA balance as authorized by the Commission, and
- d) An entry equal to interest on the average of the balance in the account during the month, calculated in the manner described in Preliminary Statement, Part I, J.

5. Disposition

The disposition of the account balance will be incorporated in SoCalGas' annual PPP gas surcharge rate update filing for PPP rates effective January 1 of the following year.
