Subject: To Correct Error in the Exchange Rate Shown in Schedule No. GT-SWGX

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for filing with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its Schedule No. GT-SWGX (GT-SWGX), Exchange Wholesale Natural Gas Service applicable to Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest), as shown on Attachment B.

Purpose

This filing corrects the inadvertent error in the rate (Exchange Rate) SoCalGas charges Southwest for exchange transportation service pursuant to GT-SWGX.

Background

On March 29, 2013, SoCalGas filed Tier 1 Advice No. (AL) 4478 to increase the Exchange Rate SoCalGas charges Southwest for exchange transportation service pursuant to GT-SWGX. The Exchange Rate recovers certain exchange fees charged by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) to SoCalGas plus SoCalGas' system balancing costs, and applies only to gas quantities delivered to Southwest through delivery points served by PG&E. AL 4478 was approved by the Commission on May 9, 2013 and became effective on April 1, 2013.

It has recently come to SoCalGas' attention that there was a mistake in its system balancing cost adder (SBCA) used to calculate the Exchange Rate in its AL 4478. AL 4478 shows an SBCA of 0.124¢/therm instead of the correct SBCA of 0.122¢/therm. Had AL 4478 shown the correct SBCA of 0.122¢/therm, the Exchange Rate would have increased to only 4.296¢/therm rather than the 4.298¢/therm, reflecting the sum of the filed PG&E exchange fee of 4.174¢/therm and the corrected SBCA of 0.122¢/therm.

This filing corrects that inadvertent error as shown on Attachment B.

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SoCalGas is working with Southwest to refund the overcollection.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is August 19, 2013. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. Schedule No. GT-SWGX EXCHANGE WHOLESALE NATURAL GAS SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable for exchange transportation service exchange with Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") in order to serve Southwest Gas Corporation's ("Customer") PG&E Points of Delivery located in Customer's service territory in southern California.

TERRITORY

Delivery points shall be as specified in the executed Master Services Contract, Schedule A, Intrastate Transmission Service, dated December 10, 2008 ("Contract").

RATES

Exchange Fee Charges

As specified in the Contract, the Exchange Rate recovers certain exchange fees charged by PG&E to Utility plus Utility's system balancing costs, and applies only to gas quantities delivered through Points of Delivery served by PG&E. Pursuant to the Contract, the Exchange Rate shall automatically change if the Commission approves modification to any of the tariffed components of the formula used to determine the exchange fee.

Pisgah Meter Station Charges

As specified in the Contract, Pisgah Meter Station Charges are monthly charges associated with the Pisgah Meter Station Upgrade.

Billing Adjustments

Billing adjustments may be necessary to reflect changes in quantities used in developing prior periods' exchange charges.

Rates may be adjusted to reflect any applicable taxes, franchise or other fees, regulatory surcharges, and interstate or intrastate pipeline charges that may occur.
