Subject: Curtailment of OSD Service on December 5, 2013

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits this advice letter to notify the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) and affected parties of a curtailment event in its service territory.¹

At approximately 12:30 P.M. on December 5, 2013, SoCalGas curtailed scheduled interruptible off system deliveries (OSDs) to six customers as a result of underscheduling of gas into the SoCalGas system. At the same time, SoCalGas also suspended further OSD service until further notice. Pursuant to D.11-03-029, SoCalGas is required to curtail or reduce interruptible OSD nominations if system integrity cannot be maintained with the nominated level of interruptible OSD service.²

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter which is December 26, 2013. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
