Subject: Curtailment of Standby Service on February 6, 2014

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits this advice letter to notify the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) and affected parties of a curtailment event in its service territory.¹

At approximately 8:00 A.M. on February 6, 2014, SoCalGas notified customers that it will be curtailing Standby Procurement Service beginning at 8:00 A.M. on February 6, 2014, and continuing until further notice. This curtailment of Standby Procurement Service is being instituted in accordance with Section C(1) of SoCalGas' Rule No. 23 and is necessitated by inadequate quantities of gas being delivered into the SoCalGas system. SoCalGas is taking this step to minimize or alleviate the need for curtailment of higher priority service.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter which is February 26, 2014. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
