Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) this partial supplement to Advice No. (AL) 4668, filed on July 8, 2014, requesting approval of five contracts SoCalGas entered into with two of its Mexican affiliates for interruptible transmission capacity pursuant to the tariffs of the affiliates and related administrative services.

Purpose

This partial supplement corrects the tier classification of AL 4668 from Tier 2 (effective after staff approval) to Tier 3 (effective after Commission approval).
