Purpose

At the request of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or CPUC) Energy Division staff, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), on behalf of itself, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E), and Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas), together the Investor Owned Utilities (IOUs), hereby submits measure code information to supplement the IOUs' request for approval of PG&E Advice 3538-G-A/4544-E; SDG&E Advice 2677-E/2341-G; and SoCalGas Advice 4723-G filed on December 5, 2014 (original Advice Letter (AL)). The original AL requested an increase in the incentive level for gas and electric griddles, an energy efficiency measure offered in the Statewide Commercial Energy Efficiency (EE) Program.

The IOUs request approval effective January 1, 2015, for a change in the incentive structure for its Commercial Griddles measure offered in each IOU's respective
