Subject: SoCalGas Quarterly Notice on the Energy Data Request Program

Purpose

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 9 of Decision (D.) 14-05-016, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits this advice letter to notify the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) of the transfer of information in SoCalGas' Energy Data Request Program (EDRP), from December 1, 2014 to March 31, 2015.

Background

On May 5, 2014 the Commission issued D.14-05-016 which adopted rules that provide access to energy usage and usage-related data to local government entities, researcher, and state and federal agencies when such access is consistent with state law and the Commission's Privacy Rules. To facilitate this data access, D.14-05-016 adopted a Data Request and Release Process that SoCalGas, San Diego Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, and Pacific Gas and Electric Company (collectively referred to as the "IOUs") must follow to receive and fulfill requests for data covered by D.14-05-016.¹ On July 30, 2014, SoCalGas filed a Tier 2 Advice Letter to establish the DRRP through a service offering referred to as the EDRP.² Among other requirements, D.14-05-016 requires the IOUs to file quarterly Tier 1 Advice Letters to publicly note the transfer of information, amend its tariffs, and update the Data Catalog.³

Information

On December 1, 2014, SoCalGas initiated its EDRP portal to: 1) receive all requests for data; 2) post details of the data requests; and 3) track the progress and status of IOUs'

responses to those data requests.

From December 1, 2014 to March 31, 2014, SoCalGas has fulfilled three data requests from local government entities, researchers and/or state and federal agencies, as shown on attachment A.

Protest
