# Subject: Partial Localized Interruptible and Firm Curtailment on April 21, 2015

#### <u>Purpose</u>

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits this advice letter to notify the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) and affected parties of a curtailment event in its service territory.<sup>1</sup>

## **Background**

SoCalGas' Rule No. 30, Transportation of Customer-Owned Gas, provides that the Utility may interrupt the gas transmission service for the purpose of testing, altering, enlarging or repairing its facility or property comprising of its system as long as priority of service is in accordance with provisions of Rule No. 23, Continuity of Service and Interruption of Delivery.

## Information

SoCalGas initiated a partial localized interruptible and firm curtailment on noncore customers beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 21, 2015 and is expected to be completed at approximately 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 22, 2015 in order to facilitate Pipeline Integrity work. Affected firm and interruptible customers will have gas service on a reduced basis during the curtailment.

SoCalGas' affected customers are located in the city of El Segundo in the area south of Grand Avenue, west of Vista del Mar Blvd., north of 45th Street, and east of the coastline. Refer to the map provided in Attachment A showing the general area affected.

SoCalGas provided advanced notification to affected customers of the pipeline maintenance and planned curtailment through their Account Representative. Subsequent notices were posted on Envoy on April 6, 2015 and April 20, 2015.<sup>2</sup>

#### Protest

The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter which is May 11, 2015. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
