**Subject: Update of Schedule G-MSUR - Transported Gas Municipal Surcharge**

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby requests California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approval of modifications to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment A.

**Purpose**

The purpose of this filing is to update SoCalGas' Schedule G-MSUR, Transported Gas Municipal Surcharge, as a consequence of SoCalGas' General Rate Case (GRC), Decision (D.) 16-06-054.

**Background**

In 1937, the California State Legislature passed "The Franchise Act of 1937" (the Act). Among other subjects, the Act established a formula whereby a utility would pay a fee to a general law city or general law county (hereinafter collectively referred to as "municipality") for the use of the streets and right-of-way in its jurisdiction.

On July 1, 2016, the Commission issued D.16-06-054 adopting, among other things, SoCalGas' revenue requirements for its Test Year 2016 GRC and post-test year ratemaking. As part of the GRC Decision, the Commission adopted a new Franchise Fee rate for SoCalGas.

**Requested Revision to Schedule No. G-MSUR**

Schedule G-MSUR sets forth the methodology by which the municipal surcharge is calculated pursuant to Chapter 2.5 of Division 3 (sections 6350, et al.) of the Public Utilities Code as enacted by Senate Bill 278/Beverly (Municipal Surcharge Law), to be applied to all transportation volumes of gas on the Utility system to customers outside the City of Los

Angeles, except for those listed under Special Condition No. 1, and to transportation volumes of gas delivered to customers within the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Section 6.1 of Los Angeles City Ordinance No. 168164. Pursuant to Public Utilities Code section 6353(d), the applicable municipal surcharge percentage is the sum of the franchise fee factor plus any franchise fee surcharge authorized for the energy transporter as approved by the Commission.

Finding of Fact 219 in SoCalGas' GRC D.16-06-054 adopted SoCalGas' forecasts for franchise fees. Therefore, the new franchise fee factor and thus municipal surcharge percentage for applicable customers outside the cities of Los Angeles, San Buenaventura, Huntington Beach, Visalia, and Bakersfield is 1.4136%, while the new municipal surcharge percentage within the cities of San Buenaventura, Huntington Beach, Visalia, and Bakersfield, which includes a 1.0000% franchise fee surcharge, is 2.4136%. The municipal surcharge percentage within the city of Los Angeles remains at 2.0000%.

Additionally, G-MSUR references a "gross-to-net" factor, which is used in the calculation of the municipal surcharge in order to remove franchise fees included in the Adjusted Core Procurement Charge, G-CPA. The new gross-to-net factor is 98.5864%.

The Rates section of Schedule G-MSUR has been updated to reflect the new surcharge percentages and gross-to-net factor discussed herein, and is shown in Attachment A.

### **Protest**

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is August 22, 2016. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. - Applicable surcharge percentage,
- Adjusted Core Procurement Charge, G-CPA, set forth in Schedule No. G-CP,
- Gross-to-net factor of 98.5864% (to remove franchise fees included in rate G-CPA), and
- Terms of gas transported during the billing period.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The following customers located outside the City of Los Angeles are exempt from Schedule G-MSUR pursuant to the terms of SB 278:
  - a. The State of California or a political subdivision (county) thereof.
  - b. Interutility gas service, where gas is transported through the Utility service territory for consumption outside the Utility's service territory.
