Subject: Supplement - Emergency Localized Curtailment on August 5, 2016

<u>Purpose</u>

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits this Advice Letter to notify the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) and affected parties of a curtailment event in its service territory.¹

This supplemental filing replaces in its entirety Advice No. 5009, filed on August 5, 2016, to revise the description of the impacted area in the city of El Segundo and the map provided in Attachment A showing the general affected area.

Information

A. Facts Underlying and Reasons for the Curtailment

SoCalGas initiated a localized partial curtailment of service to three noncore customers in the city of El Segundo beginning at 6:00 p.m. on August 5, 2016 and continuing through 12:00 p.m. on August 9, 2016, or until work is completed. SoCalGas is implementing this localized curtailment in order to perform emergency repair work on one of its transmission lines. At approximately 8:00 a.m. on August 4, 2016, as part of routine maintenance, SoCalGas identified a condition on a transmission line requiring immediate attention. As a result, SoCalGas reduced pressure to address the condition, resulting in a partial reduction in natural gas service to three noncore customers.

Affected customers are all located in the city of El Segundo. The impacted area is south of El Segundo Blvd., west of Sepulveda Blvd. to Vista del Mar Blvd. east of the coastline, and

north of 45th Street. Refer to the map provided in Attachment A showing the general affected area.

B. Compliance with SoCalGas' Tariffs

This curtailment was instituted in accordance with Section E.2 of Rule No. 30, Transportation of Customer-Owned Gas, and Section C.1 of Rule No. 23, Continuity of Service and Interruption of Delivery.

C. Efforts by SoCalGas to Minimize or Alleviate the Curtailment

SoCalGas has notified the affected customers of the emergency pipeline maintenance and curtailment of service through their Account Managers and via our Envoy electronic bulletin board. Notices were posted on Envoy on August 5, 2016 and August 8, 2016.²

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is August 28, 2016. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
