Subject: Expedited Advice Letter Approval for Interstate Capacity Contract

Purpose

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) respectfully requests approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission) of an interstate capacity contract.

Background

Under the interstate capacity acquisition procedure approved in Decision (D.) 04-09-022, contracts for interstate capacity supported by the Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) and The Utility Reform Network (TURN) may be submitted for approval to the Commission by an Expedited Advice Letter. ORA has been consulted and does not oppose the capacity contract as described. TURN has been consulted and does not offer an opinion on the capacity contract as described.

Description of Contract

The terms of the contract are confidential and are described in Attachment A. This submittal will not create any deviations from SoCalGas' tariffs, cause withdrawal of service from any present customer, or impose any more or less restrictive conditions.

Confidentiality

Due to the confidential nature of the contract which contains market-sensitive negotiated core capacity contract terms, a Confidential Attachment A, pursuant to General Order (GO) 66-D, Section 583 of the Public Utilities Code, and D.17-09-023 is being provided to Energy Division and ORA, and to TURN under the confidentiality

provisions of a non-disclosure agreement. A declaration requesting confidential treatment is being provided to the Commission concurrently with this Advice Letter, pursuant to D.17-09-023.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 10 days of the date this Expedited Advice Letter was submitted with the Commission, which is August 13, 2018.
