Subject: Establishment of the General Rate Case Memorandum Account 2019 (GRCMA2019) Pursuant to Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ) Ruling Regarding Application (A.) 17-10-008

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment A.

<u>Purpose</u>

This submittal revises SoCalGas' Preliminary Statement, Part VI, Description and Listing of Regulatory Memorandum Accounts, in compliance with ALJ Lirag's ruling dated June 7, 2018, which grants SoCalGas the authority to establish the GRCMA2019.

Background

SoCalGas submitted its General Rate Case (GRC) Application (A.)17-10-008 on October 6, 2017, requesting Commission authority to update its Test Year 2019 gas revenue requirement and base rates, effective January 1, 2019. A.17-10-008 was consolidated with San Diego Gas & Electric Company's (SDG&E) Application A.17-10-007 on November 8, 2017.

The scope of A.17-10-007/-008 (cons.) is broad and includes the traditional review of current utility spending and related issues including investment planning, safety and reliability, customer service, and all aspects of utility operations. Recognizing that the schedule of the proceeding precludes its completion in time for rates to be effective on January 1, 2019, SoCalGas and SDG&E submitted a Joint Motion on March 27, 2018,

to request authority to establish respective memorandum accounts to record the shortfall or overcollection resulting from the difference between the revenue requirement and corresponding rates currently in effect for utility service and the final revenue requirement and corresponding rates to be adopted by the Commission (which will be retroactive to January 1, 2019). ALJ Lirag's ruling dated June 7, 2018 granted the authority for each utility to establish the GRCMA2019. The creation of a memorandum account is consistent with the Commission's objectives to leave both SoCalGas' customers and shareholders essentially indifferent to the precise date that a final decision is issued in A.17-10-007/-008 (cons.), and GRC rates implemented.

Protests

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is August 28, 2018. The address for mailing or delivering a protest to the Commission is:

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1. Purpose

The GRCMA2019 is an interest-bearing memorandum account that is recorded on the Utility's financial statements. Pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Granting the Joint Motion by SoCalGas and SDG&E to Establish General Rate Case Memorandum Accounts dated June 7, 2018, the purpose of this account is to record the shortfall or overcollection resulting from the difference between the revenue requirement and corresponding rates in effect on January 1, 2019 for utility service and the final revenue requirement and corresponding rates adopted by the Commission in a decision for Application (A.) 17-10-008. The GRCMA2019 is effective January 1, 2019.

2. Applicability

This account shall apply to all gas customers except for those specifically excluded by the Commission.

3. <u>Rates</u>

See Disposition Section. The balance in the GRCMA2019 will be included in gas transportation rates upon Commission approval.

4. Accounting Procedures

Utility shall maintain the GRCMA2019 by making the following entries detailed below.

- a. A debit entry equal to the pro rata allocation of SoCalGas' annual base margin revenue requirement adopted in A.17-10-008 for the period January 1, 2019 until the effective date of rates adopted in a decision for A.17-10-008. This entry will be recorded once the decision is approved.
- b. A credit entry equal to the pro rata allocation of SoCalGas' current annual base margin revenue requirement for each month beginning January 1, 2019 until the effective date of rates adopted in a decision for A.17-10-008. This entry will be recorded once the decision is approved.
- c. An entry equal to the amortization of the GRCMA2019 balance as authorized by the Commission; and
- d. An entry equal to the interest on the average balance in the account during the month, calculated in the manner described in the Preliminary Statement, Part I, J.

5. <u>Disposition</u>

The GRCMA2019 will be amortized in connection with the implementation of GRC rates adopted in a decision for A.17-10-008, SoCalGas' 2019 GRC. The GRCMA2019 balance will be amortized on Equal Percent of Authorized Margin ("EPAM") basis.
