Subject: Establishment of the Officer Compensation Memorandum Account 2019 (OCMA2019) Pursuant to Resolution E-4963

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby requests California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approval of modifications to its Preliminary Statement, Part VI, Memorandum Accounts, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment A.

Purpose

This submittal complies with Ordering Paragraphs (OPs) 1 and 2 of Commission Resolution (Res.) E-4963, which requires and grants SoCalGas the authority to establish the OCMA2019 described herein. The OCMA2019 is created as a tracking account and does not post to SoCalGas' financial statements.

Background

On September 21, 2018, the Governor approved Senate Bill (SB) 901, which repealed and replaced Section 706 of the Public Utilities Code (among other things). Newly enacted Section 706 (effective January 1, 2019) reads as follows:

706.

- (a) For purposes of this section, "compensation" means any annual salary, bonus, benefits, or other consideration of any value, paid to an officer of an electrical corporation or gas corporation.
- (b) An electrical corporation or gas corporation shall not recover expenses for compensation from ratepayers. Compensation shall be paid solely by shareholders of the electrical corporation or gas corporation.

Res. E-4963, approved by the Commission on December 13, 2018, partially implements new Section 706 by requiring certain investor-owned utilities (IOUs), including SoCalGas, "to establish memorandum accounts to track officer compensation ... so that such amounts may be refunded to ratepayers through future proceedings." (Res. E-4963, Finding 6.) For the purposes of the OCMA2019 and pursuant to Res. E-4963, the term "officer" means those employees in positions with titles of Vice President or above, consistent with Rule 240.3b-7 of the Securities Exchange Act.

Establishment of the OCMA2019

OP 2 of Res. E-4963 instructs IOUs (including SoCalGas) to submit a Tier 1 Advice Letter implementing their respective Memorandum Accounts no later than 10 days from the date of the resolution to establish an OCMA with an effective date of January 1, 2019. Therefore, SoCalGas is herein requesting Commission approval of its OCMA2019,¹ with an effective date of January 1, 2019, and consistent modifications to its Preliminary Statement, Part VI, Memorandum Accounts, as shown in Attachment A.

The amounts tracked in the OCMA2019 will be subject to review and refund to ratepayers in future GRC proceedings.

Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is January 10, 2019. ¹ SoCalGas' existing tariffs include a memorandum account named "Officer Compensation Memorandum Account" or OCMA, which was established pursuant to D.16-06-054. E-4963 (p. 8) denies the closure of existing officer compensation memorandum accounts for all affected IOUs, which includes SoCalGas. Accordingly, SoCalGas' "OCMA" established pursuant to D.16-06-054 remains open, and SoCalGas' new memorandum account established pursuant to E-4963 is titled "OCMA2019."

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1. Purpose

The OCMA2019 is created as a tracking account and does not post to SoCalGas' financial statements. The OCMA2019 is established pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 706, as enacted by Senate Bill 901 (2018, Dodd). Public Utilities Code Section 706 requires, among other things, that all forms of compensation for officers of electrical or gas corporations shall be paid solely by shareholders. The purpose of the OCMA2019 is to track the difference between (1) compensation for officers of the utility that is authorized in General Rate Cases (GRC) or resolutions and; (2) all compensation as defined by Public Utilities Code Section 706. The term "officer" shall be defined as those employees of the investor owned utilities in positions with titles of Vice President or above, consistent with Rule 240.3b-7 of the Securities Exchange Act. The OCMA2019 is effective January 1, 2019 until closed at the direction of the Commission.

The OCMA2019 consists of two sub-accounts:

- a. Authorized Compensation Sub-Account tracks GRC authorized salaries, bonuses, benefits, and all other consideration of any value paid to officers.
- b. Total Compensation Sub-Account tracks actual salaries, bonuses, benefits, and all other consideration of any value to officers.

2. Applicability

See Disposition section.

3. Accounting Procedures

SoCalGas shall maintain this account by making monthly entries (or annual entries where applicable and monthly data is not available) as follows:

- a. Authorized Compensation Sub-Account
 - 1. A credit entry equal to the GRC authorized salaries, bonuses, benefits, and all other consideration of any value set aside to be paid to its officers as authorized in SoCalGas' 2019 GRC effective January 1, 2019.

Benefits: Employer portion of health and welfare premiums; Other Consideration: Executive perquisites in payroll data and/or invoices, 401(k) company match,

deferred compensation company match.

4. <u>Disposition</u>

The OCMA2019 balance may be addressed in SoCalGas' GRC or other appropriate Commission proceeding to determine whether the balance should be refunded to customers in rates.
