## Subject: April 2020 Standby Procurement Charges

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown in Attachment A.

## <u>Purpose</u>

This routine monthly submittal updates the Standby Procurement Charges in Schedule No. G-IMB for April 2020.

## **Background**

Resolution G-3316, dated May 24, 2001, and Advice No. (AL) 4133, submitted on July 2, 2010 and effective on August 1, 2010, revised the Schedule No. G-IMB Standby Procurement Charge for negative monthly transportation imbalances that exceed the 8% tolerance band. AL 5179, submitted on August 28, 2017 and effective October 1, 2017, revised the Schedule No. G-IMB Standby Procurement Charge by replacing the "InterContinental Daily Indices – SoCal Border" with "SNL Energy's Daily Indices – SoCal Border." The Standby Procurement Charges are:

 Calculated at 150% of the highest daily border price index at the Southern California border for the period plus a Brokerage Fee of 0.266¢ per therm for noncore retail service and all wholesale service, and 0.207¢ per therm for core retail service. The highest daily border price index is an average of the highest prices from "NGI's Daily Gas Price Index - Southern California Border Average" and "SNL Energy's Daily Indices - SoCal Border."

- 2. Calculated for a period that begins from the first day of the "flow month" (the month that the imbalance is incurred) and ends five days prior to the start of the imbalance trading period.
- 3. Posted at least one day in advance of the imbalance trading period.

## **Information**

For the "flow month" of April 2020 (covering the period April 1, 2020 to May 20, 2020), the highest daily border price index at the Southern California border is \$0.19740 per therm. The resultant Standby Procurement Charges, calculated in the manner set forth above, are \$0.29876 per therm for noncore retail service and all wholesale service, and \$0.29817 per therm for core retail service. The work paper showing details of the calculation of these rates is incorporated herein as Attachment B.

## Protest

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is June 10, 2020. The address for mailing or delivering a protest to the Commission is:

#### Standby Procurement Charge

This charge is applied to customer's cumulative negative transportation imbalance (confirmed transportation deliveries less actual usage) exceeding the 8 percent tolerance band. The Standby Procurement Charge is posted at least one day in advance of each corresponding imbalance trading period for noncore/wholesale and core transport agents (CTAs). It is calculated at 150% of the highest daily border price index at the Southern California border beginning on the first day of the month that the imbalance is created to five days prior to the start of each corresponding imbalance trading period plus a Brokerage Fee of 0.266¢ per therm for noncore retail service and all wholesale service, and  $0.211 \not\in$  per therm for core retail service. The highest daily border price index is an average of the highest prices from "Natural Gas Intelligence's (NGI's) Daily Gas Price Index -Southern California Border Average" and "SNL Energy's Daily Indices - SoCal Border."

## **G-IMB Standby Procurement Charge Calculation**

The highest daily border price index is an average of the highest prices from "NGI's Daily Gas Price Index - Southern California Border Average" and "SNL Energy Daily Indices - SoCal Border."

The highest daily border price index for the period was on May 6, 2020

05/06/20 NGI's Daily Gas Price Index (NDGPI) = \$0.19750 per therm

05/06/20 SNL Energy Daily Indices (SNLDI) = \$0.19730 per therm

Highest Daily Border Price Index (HDBPI) = (NDGPI + SNLDI) / 2

HDBPI = \$0.19740 per therm

SP-CR (Core Retail) = 150% x HDBPI + Core Brokerage Fee

**SP-CR** = 150% x \$0.19740 + \$0.00207 = **\$0.29817** 

SP-NR (Noncore Retail) = 150% x HDBPI + Noncore Brokerage Fee
