<u>Subject</u>: Establishment of the Climate Adaptation Vulnerability Assessment Memorandum Account (CAVAMA) Pursuant to Decision (D.) 20-08-046

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or CPUC) modifications to its Preliminary Statement, Part VI, Memorandum Accounts, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment A.

<u>Purpose</u>

This submittal complies with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 10 of D.20-08-046, *Decision on Energy Utility Climate Change Vulnerability Assessments And Climate Adaptation in Disadvantaged Communities (Phase 1, Topics 4 and 5)*, to establish SoCalGas' CAVAMA.

Background

The Order Instituting Rulemaking to consider Strategies and Guidance for Climate Change Adaptation (Rulemaking or OIR) was adopted by the Commission on April 26, 2018.¹ The Rulemaking was motivated by statewide policy directives, recent climate events, as well as advancements in – and availability of – climate science data and tools for evaluating the data. The proceeding was divided into topics. D.19-10-054 covered Topic 1 – definition of climate change adaptation and Topic 2 – climate adaptation data sources, models and tools.² D.20-08-046 addressed Topic 4 - disadvantaged vulnerable communities (DVCs) and Topic 5 - vulnerability assessments (VAs).

D.20-08-046 orders Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, and SoCalGas (collectively "IOUs") to conduct VAs and Community Engagement Plans, which are due one year prior to the VAs. SoCalGas' VA is due in 2025 and the Community Engagement Plan in 2024. Further, the Decision also orders the IOUs to survey parties to this proceeding, DVCs, and Community Based Organizations with which they work and file the results of those surveys every four years, starting one year after the IOUs file their first VA.

Establishment of CAVAMA

SoCalGas proposes to establish the CAVAMA to track costs directly related to the vulnerability assessments and any incremental costs related to the community engagement, the Community Engagement Plans, and the related community engagement surveys ordered in D.20-08-046.

Protests

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date of this Advice Letter, which is October 15, 2020. The address for mailing or delivering a protest to the Commission is:

1.	Purpose
	The CAVAMA is an interest-bearing memorandum account that is recorded on the Utility's financial statements. The CAVAMA records costs directly related to the climate vulnerability assessments and any incremental costs related to the community engagement, the community engagement plans, and the related community engagement surveys, as authorized in Decision (D.) 20-08-046, Ordering Paragraph (OP) 10. The memorandum account shall not be used for other costs or assessments.
2.	Applicability
	The CAVAMA shall apply to all customers except those specifically excluded by the Commission.
3.	Rates
	The CAVAMA shall be applied to rates as described in Section 5 below.
4.	Accounting Procedures
	SoCalGas shall maintain the CAVAMA by recording entries at the end of each month as follows, net of FF&U, where applicable:
	a. A debit entry equal to the actual operation and maintenance (O&M) costs related to the vulnerability assessments and any incremental costs related to the community engagement, the community engagement plans, and the related community engagement surveys;
	b. An entry for amortization as authorized by the Commission;
	c. An entry equal to the interest on the average balance in the account at the beginning of the month and the balance after the entries above at a rate equal to 1/12 of the interest rate on three-month nonfinancial Commercial Paper for the previous month, as reported in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, H.15, or its successor publication.
5.	Disposition
	The disposition of the CAVAMA balance will be addressed in SoCalGas' next General Rate Case (GRC) or other applicable proceeding.
