#### <u>Subject</u>: Southern California Gas Company's Unspent and Uncommitted Funds for Program Year 2021 in Compliance with Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision 21-01-004

#### <u>Purpose</u>

In accordance with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 3 of Decision (D.) 21-01-004, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) hereby submits this Advice Letter (AL) to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission) to detail its 2021 unspent and uncommitted funds for the Assembly Bill (AB) 841 Schools Energy Efficiency Stimulus Program.

#### **Background**

D.21-01-004, which established directions to the investor-owned utilities (IOUs), including Pacific Gas and Electric Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company and Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas), for funding the School Energy Efficiency Stimulus Program (administered by the California Energy Commission (CEC)), authorized the Utility Audit Branch to conduct an audit of the IOUs' unspent and uncommitted energy efficiency funds for program year (PY) 2020. Unspent and uncommitted energy efficiency (EE) funds for PYs 2020, 2021, and 2022 constitute a portion of the funds to be transferred to the CEC for administration of the School Energy Efficiency Stimulus Program.

Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Kao, via e-mail ruling, directed the IOUs to each submit a Tier 2 AL no later than April 1, 2022, to true-up any PY 2021 unspent and uncommitted amounts. On March 11, 2022, pursuant to Rule 11.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the IOUs filed a joint e-mail requesting an extension for the submittal of the Tier 2 AL to true up PY 2021 unspent and uncommitted amounts. On March 14, 2022, ALJ Kao granted the IOUs request.

Finally, the e-mail ruling directed each IOU to disburse to the CEC its applicable unspent and uncommitted funds in a single lump sum after being invoiced by the CEC.

#### **Discussion**

Pursuant to ALJ Kao's e-mail ruling on December 17, 2021, and pursuant to OP 3 of D.21-01-004, SoCalGas respectfully submits the EE PY 2021 unspent and uncommitted funds (Table 1) to be disbursed to the CEC for administration of the School Energy Efficiency Stimulus Program. The PY 2021 unspent and uncommitted funds amount to \$202,247.43.
